## THE IMPLICATIONS FOR MICRO BUSINESSES

The new GDPR regulation imposes significant costs on organizations of all types and sizes. GDPR-compliance is, however, especially burdensome for micro-companies, who often lack in resources such as time, finance, staff, and knowledge, preventing them from understanding and thus meeting the GDPR requirements. This leaves them exposed to involuntary breaches which may result in high fines (up to 4% of annual income or 20M euros)
